

2016-2019: TAKING STOCK AND LOOKING TO THE FUTURE

A significant consultative Lessons Learnt exercise was conducted among Khartoum and Rabat Process partners from November 2018 to April 2019 and aimed at identifying key learnings from the JVAP follow-up*. The findings and recommendations were laid out in a Lessons Learnt Report and are summarised in this factsheet.



Added value of the JVAP database – Partners' views

- Transparency of the JVAP follow-up process and visibility of commitments from all partners
- Common JVAP repository, gathering a large number of projects/programmes and legislations/policies thoroughly checked to avoid duplication of initiatives
- Significant dataset valuably substantiating the discussions and dynamics of the Rabat and the Khartoum Processes
- Targeted analysis allowing reporting on the implementation of the JVAP from different angles including domains, priorities, funding, implementing partners, etc.

Balanced reporting

Strive for balance between the collection of projects and policies.



Broadened access

Nominate further relevant contact points who support data collection and will benefit from analysis.



Self-navigation or on-demand requests

Access data visualisations and request macro analysis for specific meetings.



Training tailored to partners' needs

Undergo introductory database or data analysis training.



M&E support (if agreed among partners)

Proactively share internal Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) framework to be streamlined with the JVAP.

Increased support

Support the partners through data collection, entry and check.

Improved analysis

Increase coherence between knowledge generation and its accessibility by providing key stakeholders with access to the database and to analysis reports at national, regional and Valletta levels.

Tailored visuals

Translate the collected data into simple and visual knowledge and into communication products.

Ongoing training

Provide technical support for the use of the database and its various functionalities.

M&E expertise

Harmonise the JVAP Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) framework.
